

## MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS

This survey was done during Summer, 1977. It covers part of the Churchyard and was not published until 2004.

In mid-1977 I was temporarily living in Winster, my birthplace. The Survey proved to be an ambitious project although I did not think so when it was started. I took garden chair, bucket, brush, soap and water and pipe and tobacco with me to the Churchyard. When I was tired or felt lazy (which was often) I sat and smoked and enjoyed the tranquillity and was bothered by no-one.

The Summer sped by but only about half of the Churchyard was surveyed.

After 1977 spare-time was never again available but I promised myself that one day I would finish the Survey and publish the results.

In the event, unknown to me, Helen Bastin started and finished her Survey. ("Winster St. John & Cemetery Memorial Inscriptions 1994 Recorded by Helen Bastin.")

My Survey (see the Plan) covers that part of the Churchyard to the South of the porch; to the East and West sides; and to the North of the Church. (Area C of Helen Bastin's complete Survey)

Some of the inscriptions may have deteriorated during the nearly 17 years which elapsed between my Survey and Helen's in which case I hope that this earlier Survey may prove to be useful.

The Plan of the Churchyard shows the approximate position of each Memorial. The main Index is alphabetical by Surname and each name is allotted a Plan No. Where I could not decipher part of the Inscription with complete confidence I used ( ) around either the letter(s) or figures in doubt thus: "I(n) Lovin(g) M(e)mory of ( )am( )s Sm( )t( ) Died ( ) J(u)ne ( )91(4)." Where ( ) appears around a blank space(s) it means that the erosion was such that I could not decipher that bit with any confidence as to accuracy.

If you spot an error then the fault lies with me alone.

I hope that there is some information here about Winster ancestors which will be of interest to you.

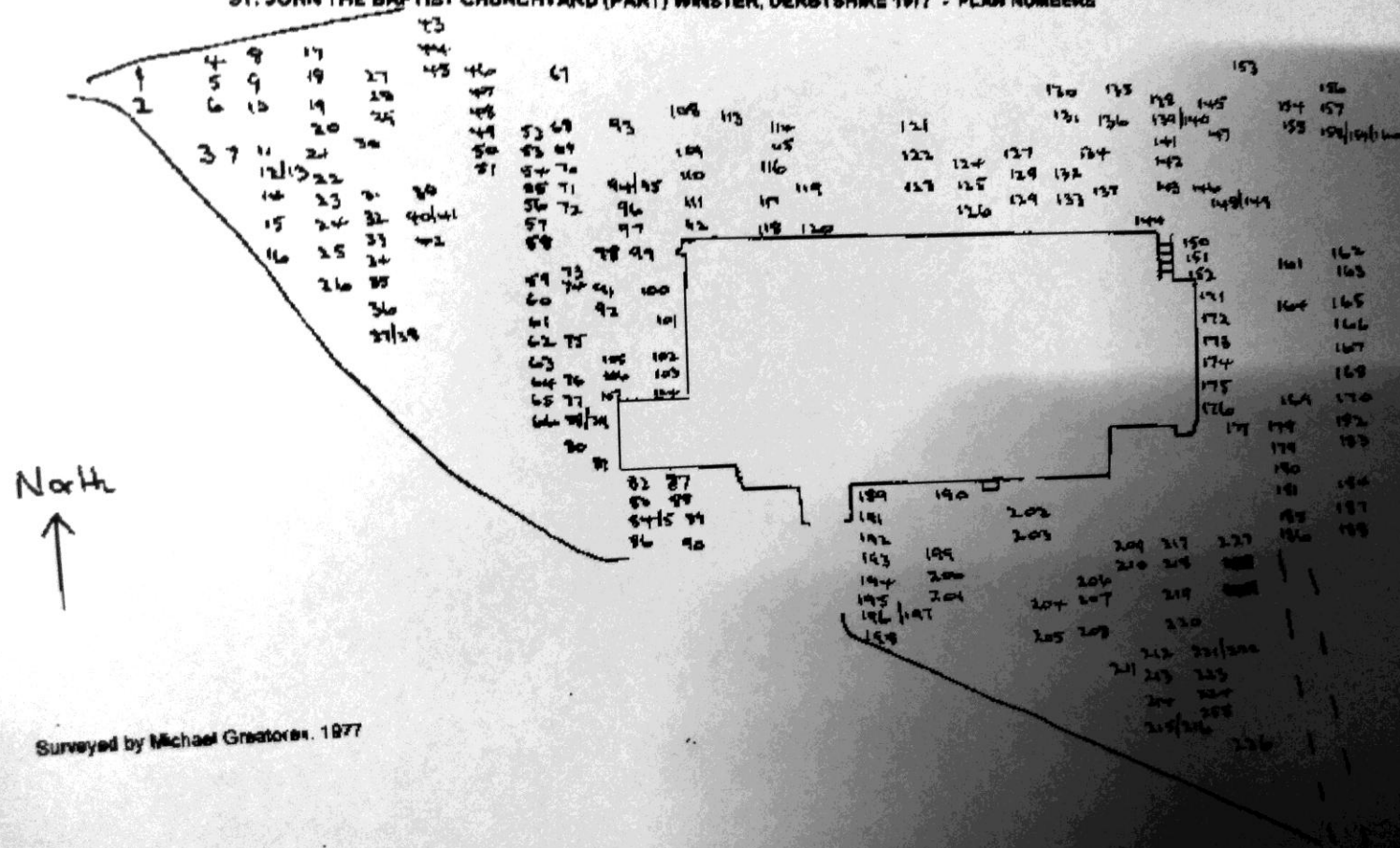
